We will be inviting those of you who are eligible for the seasonal 'Flu' vaccine to our Saturday walk in clinic November (adults and children) between 9am and 11am. You will get a text confirming the date and times a few days before. No need to book just turn up!

You will be offered a mask or a shield by reception when you arrive if you don't have a face covering with you. If the waiting room is very busy patients may be asked to wait outside. Please do not attend any routine appointments if you are unwell with a fever or cough.

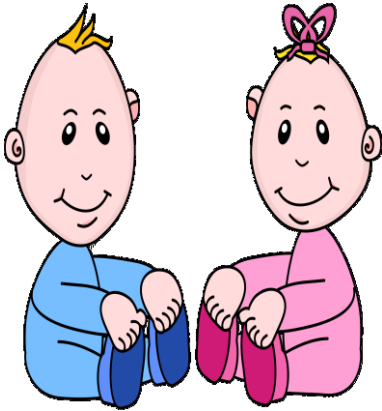
**Covid-19 Booster

All patients aged between 70 and 79 are eligible for a Shingles Vaccine. One in five people who have had chicken pox in the past will develop shingles.
